

ABOUT THE GEORGIA VECTR CENTER

The Georgia Veterans Education Career Transition Resource (VECTR) Center is the state's premier gateway for veterans' re-entry into Georgia's public postsecondary educational systems and workforce.

The VECTR Center delivers one-on-one career coaching to veterans, spouses, and adult-family members such as skillset evaluation, educational readiness, resume evaluation, and job-search guidance. The center also has an academic testing center that provides CLEP, DSST, Pearson VUE certification and proctored testing options. Our community resource representative assesses veterans' needs and connects them with outside partners to deliver the needed service or assistance.

Through on-site partners, such as Georgia Department of Veterans Service (GDVS), Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and United Way/Mission United, the center provides a one-stop-shop for veterans seeking benefits, health care enrollment and connection to community resources.

ACCELERATED PROGRAMS



Our accelerated programs are conducted by Central Georgia Technical College instructors and courses are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges.

Our accelerated programs are 15 weeks or less and are directly linked to Georgia industries but are in demand throughout the country.

Students learn specialized skills, earn technical certificates of credit, and college credits.

Most of our programs of study are approved for the Department of Defense SkillBridge program.

Transitioning service members who are stationed more than 50 miles from the Georgia VECTR Center are provided free housing if needed while participating in one of our SkillBridge programs.
