1. Question: Where can I get literature to learn more about Mansfield Oil, Inc?

2. Question: Does Mansfield Oil supply Troup county area?
Answer: No, Boswell Oil supplies Troup county area.
3. Question: Are there charges for topping off different sites on campus, e.g. generators, besides our two 55 gallon tanks, we also have 2 generators that use fuel.
Answer: No, there is no extra charge for topping off different sites.
4. Question: Is Clayton State University still under Boswell Oil?
Answer: No, Clayton State University is now under Mansfield Oil.
5. Question: If we order less than 400 gallons, is the contract still mandatory?
Answer: Yes, the contract is still mandatory. There is a minimum order surcharge for orders under 400 gallons.
6. Question: So we won't really know what the price will be when we are ordering, right?
Answer: You will know the commodity price, delivery charge may vary depending on your location.
7. Question: Is the price index to be used based on the day of order or delivery?
Answer: The price index is based on the day of delivery.
8. Question: Will this presentation be available to print?

9. Question: Can the P-card be used for these purchases.
Answer: Yes, P-cards can be used for contract purchases.
10. Question: DOT uses mobile fuel dispensing vehicles. What provisions have been made for fill up of these units?
Answer: Suppliers have agreed to deliver to any location within the county they were awarded, which should take care of filling up mobile fuel dispensing vehicles.
11. Question: Is the Federal Oil Spill Tax part of this contract? This is not a LUST tax.
Answer: Yes, FOST is part of this contract.
