



Applicants for Correctional Officer positions must meet the minimum job requirements listed below and pass the POST Entrance Exam to be considered eligible for employment:

- At least 18 years old
- High School Diploma/GED
- US Citizenship
- No Felony Convictions/ Misdemeanor of Domestic Violence
- · Pass drug test
- Physical Exam
- · Valid Driver's License

FAQs

- How do I find out what jobs are open?
 - o Go to GDCjobs.com
- What do Correctional Officers Do?
 - o There are many different positions within a facility for officers:
 - Perimeter Control rides in a vehicle and patrols the perimeter
 - Front Gate controls keys, allow people into the facility
 - Main Control calls for counts, watches cameras, allows people further into the facility
 - Dorm Control supervises offenders in the dorms
 - Medical Officer assures offenders get to appointments
 - Gym Officer supervises offenders in the gym
 - Segregation/Isolation oversees offenders in lock down
 - Education Officer assures offenders get to classes
- How do I go about applying to be a Correctional Officer?
 - o Go to GDCjobs.com and fill out an application
 - o Go to any facility and fill out an application
- What if I fail the Accuplacer test?
 - The Accuplacer can be retaken anytime
- How long does it take to get a job as a Correctional Officers?
 - We have one-stop-shops where you can be given a provisional offer the same day
 - o The hire date depends a lot on when you can get all the paperwork in to us
- What are the minimum qualifications for a Correctional Officer?
 - o High School diploma or GED
 - o No felony convictions
 - o Pass a physical test consisting of sit-ups, pushups and running a mile
 - Pass the Accuplacer Test
 - Pass the Integrity Test
 - Pass a drug screen
- How long does it take to become a Correctional Officer?
 - You remain a cadet until you have successfully passed Basic Correctional Officer Training
 - o Basic Correctional Officer Training is scheduled soon after you are hired
- How physically capable do I have to be to become a Correctional Officer?
 - o Males must complete 8 pushups, 12 sit-ups and a 16-minute mile
 - o Females must complete 4 pushups, 8 sit-ups and a 16-minute mile
- How long is the Basic Correctional Officers Training?
 - o Five weeks

- Where and when do I have to go for Correctional Officer training?
 - o Training is scheduled soon after your hire date
 - o The training is located at State Offices South at Tift College
- Do I have to pay for Basic Correctional Officer Training?
 - o No, the agency incurs the cost for this training
- Do I go to school immediately?
 - o Soon after hire, depending on the schedule of training
- How many hours a week do Correctional Officers work?
 - Correctional Officers work a 28-day cycle, during which they work 14 of the 28 days
- What are the work hours?
 - o Correctional Officers work 12-hours shifts
 - o Typically, a new officer will work night hours
- How much is a Correctional Officer paid?
 - o In a level 5 facility, officers start at \$41,844
 - In a level 3 facility, officers start at \$38,040
- What are the negative parts about becoming a Correctional Officer?
 - Being away from family for five weeks during training; however, you do go home on weekends
 - o Working with offenders with violent pasts that may conflict with your beliefs
- Do I still have to go through Georgia's Basic Correctional Officer training if I'm POST certified in another state?
 - Yes, because the requirements may be different
- Can I still become a Correctional Officer if I don't have my high school diploma or GED?
 - o No, that is a requirement of the job
- What if I move and want to go to another facility?
 - o If it can be accommodated, and is approved, a transfer can happen
- When do I get my first paycheck?
 - o Paychecks are administered on the 15th and the last day of the month
 - Everyone is paid "current" so you will receive your first check on one of these days
- What do I need to wear when I come to work?
 - o Cadets wear khaki pants and a black polo shirt
- I am in the reserve, how does that work?
 - GDC recognizes the schedule of the reserves

Instructions & Requirements for Applying for a Job with GDC

Application Instructions

All vacancy announcements for the Georgia Department of Corrections (GDC) will be posted on GDCJobs.com. This site is updated daily. Each vacancy announcement listed at this site will include a contact person with a phone number, fax number, physical mailing address and/or e-mail address for that contact person. You will apply directly to that location/contact person in order to apply for a specific vacancy.

In order to apply for a job with GDC, all applicants will do the following:

- View the vacancy announcements on GDCJobs.com and determine which jobs and/or locations
 you wish to be considered for employment.
- 2. Determine whether you meet the minimum qualifications for the job(s) in which you are interested in applying. The minimum qualifications are the first measure of qualification for a specific job and will determine whether your application will be further considered for that job.
- 3. Click on the Apply Now to send your application directly to the facility or you may choose to do one of the following: Send your application or resume to the attention of the contact person via e-mail, fax or physical mailing address within the application period indicated in the announcement. Applications received after the closing date will not be accepted. You may also contact the contact person to ask questions about the job and to ask any questions you may have concerning the application process.
- 4. If further information is needed to complete your application, you will be contacted by the contact person for that job announcement or work location.

It is important that you send your application directly to the contact person and/or location in the vacancy announcement. Applications sent to another location will not be forwarded and may result in you not being considered for jobs in which you intended to submit an application.

Correctional Officer Applicant Information & Requirements

Required Documentation:

- A completed State of Georgia Application for Employment
- High School Diploma or state issued GED Certificate (Sealed/Certified copy of High School Transcripts)
- Social Security Card or other official document to establish employment eligibility
- Birth Certificate or other recognized proof of birth
- Valid Driver's License or other official document to establish identity
- DD214 or equivalent (if applicable)
- Selective Service Registration Card or proof of being exempt from registration (male applicants only between 18 and 26 years of age)

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

- At least 18 years of age
- **■** A US Citizen
- High School diploma or state issued GED Certificate (Sealed/Certified copy of High School Transcripts)
- Possess good moral character
- Complete a personal interview
- Free from any physical, emotional or mental condition which might adversely affect exercising the essential tasks or duties of a peace officer
- Successfully complete the POST Entrance Examinations (Accuplacer) (A college degree can be substituted)
- No felony convictions, misdemeanor of domestic violence or multiple misdemeanors

Minimum Physical Requirements:

- Female applicants: 4 pushups in one minute, 8 sit-ups in one minute and run one mile in 16 minutes or less
- Male applicants: 8 pushups in one minute, perform 12 sit-ups in one minute, and run one mile in 16 minutes or less
- Be physically capable of carrying out the duties of his or her appointment

- Vision -- minimum vision of 20/40 in each eye, corrected or uncorrected (with or without glasses or contact lenses). Adequate depth perception and the ability to distinguish colors
- Peripheral vision -- at least 70 degrees in each eye
- Hearing Hearing loss no greater than 24dB (decibels) for the average of frequencies 500Hz, 1000Hz, 2000Hz, and 3000Hz in the better ear, unaided (without a hearing aid) or aided (with a hearing aid)

GDC Requirements:

- Must successfully meet all the requirements of the Peace Officer Standards & Training Council (POST)
- **■** Receive POST Certification

NOTE: Applicants who do not meet the Minimum Qualifications, cannot become a GDC Correctional Officer

Employment Information:

All applicants must be willing to work any shift. Shift assignments are not permanent and are subject to change. Applicants must be willing to:

- Have a criminal background investigation
- Have a pre-employment drug screening
- Take and pass the POST Entrance Exam (Accuplacer Test). Accuplacer scores must be in a sealed envelope confirming passing Accuplacer scores. (A college degree can be substituted)
- Take and pass an online GDC integrity test (only available from GDC Human Resources)
- Complete medical examination (Paid for by GDC if they use one of the GDC contracted facilities)

If hired, employee must:

- Provide drivers history for past seven years if they have possessed a license in any state other than Georgia
- Attend Five-week Basic Correctional Officer Training course
- Become POST certified



ALL Correctional Officer Applicants must pass the POST Entrance Exam (Accuplacer Test) to be considered for employment opportunities.

Vacancy information is located on the GDC Employment website at jobs.gdc.ga.gov.

POST Entrance Examination (Accuplacer Test)

On December 10, 2008, POST Council adopted the ASSET and COMPASS test as the official POST Entrance Examination (Accuplacer). Therefore, effective March 1, 2016, the official entrance exam will be the Accuplacer test required for admission to the Technical College System of Georgia colleges. When an individual passes the required POST entrance exam (Accuplacer), the individual has met the state requirement for the POST certification application process. Individuals may test at any Technical College System of Georgia location, and details on how to schedule an appointment to take one of these tests are available from these locations. The POST entrance exam access form will be required to take this exam for the purpose of attending any basic law enforcement course, and this form may be obtained from the POST web site. Please be aware that if an individual can prove successful completion of other college admission tests which are provided at the end of this notice, they will be deemed to have satisfied the requirements of the POST Entrance Examination (Accuplacer). Applicants obtaining a passing score on the POST Entrance Exam (Accuplacer) may be considered for Correctional Officer vacancies.

The POST Entrance Examination (Accuplacer) consists of two sections:

- Reading Comprehension The ACCUPLACER Reading Comprehension section of the exam consists of 20 questions which test your ability to identify the differences between main ideas and supporting ideas and understand direct statements, inferences, and applications within a literary text
- Sentence Skills The Sentence Skills section of the ACCUPLACER exam consists of 20 questions that test your knowledge of syntax, specifically targeting the ability to recognize complete sentences, identify coordinate and subordinate clauses, and use clear sentence logic. Information to bring to the POST Entrance Examination (Accuplacer):
- Applicants should bring a government issued ID card (Driver's License).
