Bachelor's degree in engineering from an A.B.E.T. accredited program OR equivalent degree in a related field and 5 years of job-related experience without EIT OR a Valid Engineering -in-Training (EIT) certificate and one (1) year of job- related experience OR Professional Engineer (PE) license issued by the State of Georgia and one (1) year of job- related experience.

Note For International degrees: Applicants with a bachelor's degree from an international institution must submit a course-by-course evaluation from a GDOT approved credentialing provider.
