




Location of People in Accountant, Auditor/Examiner, and Financial Ops Generalist

452 people who work in these jobs live in counties in the Atlanta Regional Commission, while 380 live in other counties across the state



Accountant Education Level at Time of Hire





Auditor/Examiner Education Level at Time of Hire




