eSource				
New Functionality:	 Effective September 15, 2010, State Purchasing is pleased to announce the release of eSource, a new version of eQuote with increased functionality. Examples include: automating receipt of the supplier's certificate of non-collusion automating the Notice of Intent to Award and Notice of Award processes supporting two-step Requests for Qualified Contractors (RFQCs) process in which the RFQC qualifies the suppliers and a second solicitation is used to make contract award supporting Requests for Proposals (RFPs) supporting Requests for Information (RFIs) (no contract award is made) increasing award options The expanded functionality of eSource has no effect on each State Entity's current delegated Purchasing Authority (DPA). 			
Revised Policy:	 eSource is the electronic sourcing tool for all state entities not currently using Team Georgia Marketplace [™]. The revised policy for eSource is as follows: <u>Optional Use</u>: State entities may use eSource to conduct RFIs, RFQCs and RFPs. State entities may also use eSource to conduct RFQs for construction or public works. <u>Required Use</u>: State Purchasing mandated use of eQuote for processing RFQs in November 2008. State entities are required to continue to use eSource to process all RFQs (other than RFQs for construction or public works). <u>Prohibited Use</u>: Sole source notices may NOT be posted in eSource. Sole source notices must be published directly to the Georgia Procurement Registry. The Georgia Procurement Manual will be updated later this year to reflect the policy changes in this Official Announcement.
