

COMMUNICATIONS ALERT

The Georgia Department of Administrative Services, State Purchasing Division (SPD), would like to make you aware the current Master Agreement between NASPO ValuePoint (NASPO) and United Parcel Service (UPS) for Expedited Delivery Services and the state's Participating Addendum to that Master Agreement (SWC#99999-SPD-S20210412-001) are set to expire on November 27, 2021. While a new Master Agreement is currently under negotiation, we do not anticipate the completion of these negotiations and the issuance of a new Master Agreement by the expiration date. SPD cannot begin negotiating a new Participating Addendum until the new Master Agreement has been finalized.

SPD has been advised by UPS that state customers currently utilizing UPS will be moved to **UPS's published** (commercial) pricing schedule and terms, effective 11/28/2021. Any customer that wishes to continue using UPS for expedited mail delivery as of 11/28/2021 may do so; however, please be advised that State negotiated pricing or terms will not be available and that total annual purchases for the remainder of the fiscal year must be less than \$25,000.

FedEx continues to be the statewide contract option for Expedited Delivery Services, beyond November 28, 2021.

- SWC #99999-SPD-S20210412-002, with FedEx, has been Extended:
 - a. The current Master Consortia Agreement between FedEx and NASPO has been extended through February 25, 2022.
 - b. The current Georgia Participating Addendum has been extended through February 25, 2022. This extension includes current terms and pricing.

We are pleased to announce that Federal Express (**FedEx**) and NASPO have reached agreement on a new Master Agreement for Expedited Delivery Services. SPD is finalizing negotiations with FedEx on the terms of a new corresponding Participating Addendum projected to go live February 26, 2022.

The FedEx statewide contract is established within Team Georgia Marketplace™. Contract information, including pricing and benefits can be found on the Supplier's Contract Summary Page located within Team Georgia Marketplace™ found on the DOAS State Purchasing website.
