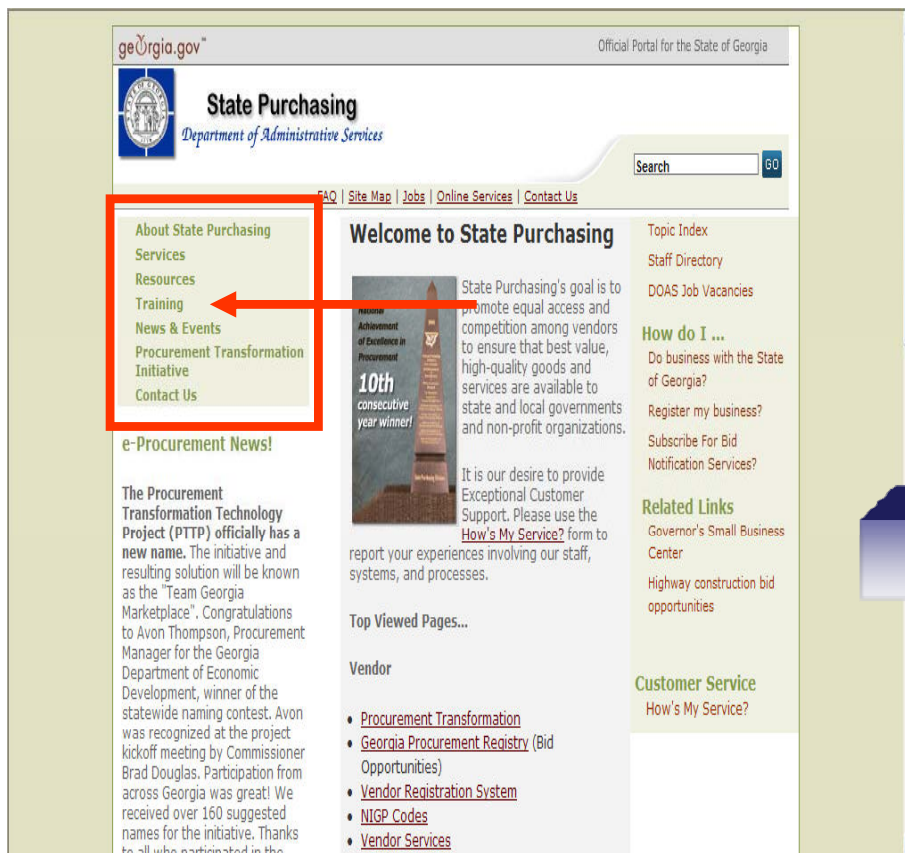

Georgia Procurement Registry
Publishes government contract opportunities through a free web-based advertising system.

Vendor Registration System
Enables vendors to register their company and identify product and service offerings through a free web-based system. Enables agencies to search for vendors in their area that provide the products and services they need. Also, search for minority and small business enterprises by geographic location.

Statewide Contracts
Establishes competitive statewide contracts for a wide variety of products, services, and equipment.

Agency Contracts Index
The Agency Contract Index (ACI) provides a comprehensive listing of all agency contracts.

Bid Posting System
Enables registered agency users to post bid notices and documents to the Georgia Procurement Registry, maintain agency user profiles, and solicit and receive bids electronically through the E-Quote system.

eQuote
Enables agency buyers to solicit and receive bids electronically by automating the "faxed bid" process through a free web-based procurement sourcing tool.

Reverse Auction
Learn how to participate in a Reverse Auction.

Vendor Relations
Trains and educates vendors on how to do business with the state of Georgia.

Questions	Answer
What types of parts are covered in the contract?	All parts that are sold by NAPA including: Batteries, Chemicals, Shop Supplies, Tools, Heavy Duty, Medium Duty, Light Duty, Marine Parts
Do I need to contact my NAPA store?	Yes, you need to contact your local NAPA store to inform them that you are interested in buying parts under the state contract.
What types of pricing discounts do I get?	 Microsoft Excel Worksheet
Can I buy parts on-line?	Yes, once you have an account set up at a NAPA store you can buy parts through ProLink

FAQs

The following list provides a list of questions and answers:



Questions	Answer
Do I need to present any identification to the NAPA store when buying parts?	If you are a repair facility the store will need to have a copy of your tax exempt form on file.
Does NAPA offer any training for my technicians and service people?	Yes, NAPA has a full compliment of on-line training as well as field resources that can come to your facility and help train individuals.
Should I order parts through napaonline.com	No, online ordering is done through ProLink for the state contract
What should we do if we are already buying parts from a NAPA store?	Let the store manager know that you are interested in participating in the State Contract program
