KNOW THE SIGNS

Stop sex trafficking and exploitation of children in Georgia.

- Has bruises in various stages of healing
- Lacks personal possessions and appears not to have a stable living situation
- Is fearful, timid, or submissive
- Appears disconnected from family, friends, community organizations, or houses of worship
- Has sudden or dramatic changes in behavior
- Shows signs of having been denied food, water, sleep, or medical care
- Appears to be coached on what to say
- Is often in the company of someone to whom he or she defers or someone who seems to be in control of the situation

While no single indicator is proof of human trafficking, these indicators are a few that may alert you to a potential human trafficking situation.
