

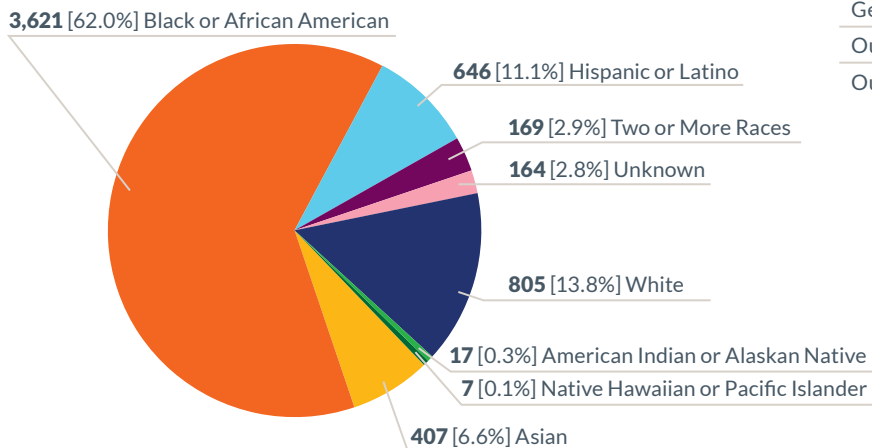

TOTAL ENROLLMENT

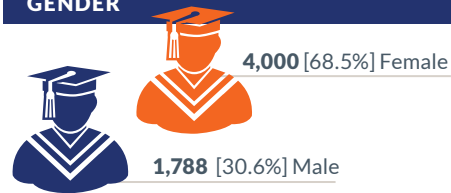
